I am writing in strong support of your proposal for an Exposition Green Corridor between Motor and Military Avenues as part of phase 2 of the Exposition Light Rail project. You are to be commended for the comprehensive nature of the Green Corridor proposal to convert underutilized property along the Exposition Right of Way into a multi-use space for transit, recreation and water filtration.

The Exposition Green Corridor Project is a proposal that will utilize public property to improve mobility, create recreational activities and cleanup groundwater. The idea of having water features throughout the parkway is the kind of thinking that we need in Los Angeles' congested urban environment. With four storm drains crossing the Right of Way on their way to Ballona Creek, this is an ideal location for a water treatment system as well as the day lighting of sections of the underground creeks to create water features for the public to enjoy.

I understand that, during the scoping process for phase two, the Green Corridor Proposal was submitted to the Exposition Metro Line Construction Authority for consideration. I am in complete support of this project; although it will require the involvement of multiple agencies, the results will be well worth the coordination.
